- How are you developing and shepherding your youth leaders, encouraging their spiritual vitality and growth?










### C.E. PLEDGE






# LESSON #6: SCRIPTURE ENGAGEMENT IN A SUPPORTIVE, THINKING CLIMATE MATTERS

- Are you providing space for honest questions in a supportive environment? Do you provide opportunities to study the Scripture on issues students raise? [Note: Power of small groups]
- How do you help youth recognize that this kind of questioning is a normal part of growing into a strong, mature faith?
- How are you modeling your own journey of questions and how God has helped?
- Do your youth know that they are loved deeply, whether or not they accept your teaching?
