(International Missions Director)

Apostle Emmanuel Agyemang Bekoe holds an MSc. (ANALYTICAL CHEMISTRY) and a BSc. (CHEMISTRY) degrees from the Kwame Nkrumah University Of Science And Technology, Kumasi. Additionally, he also holds an MA (THEOLOGY) degree from Akrofi-Christaller Institute, a Certificate in Theology from the Pentecost University and a Certificate in Basics in Biblical Greek from Zondervan.

Prior to his calling into the ministry in 2006, he worked as a Chemistry Tutor at Kumasi Academy and used to be an Assistant Examiner in Chemistry for the West Africa Examinations Council (WAEC).

He hails from Asiakwa in the Eastern Region of Ghana. His calling took him to Breman Brakwa and Winneba as District Overseer and Pastor respectively from 2007 to 2010 and 2010 to 2012. He was then called as a missionary to Uganda where he spent seven (7) years from 2012 to 2019.

Apostle Emmanuel Agyemang Bekoe was called into the Apostleship in 2016. He served as the Regional Coordinating Committee (RCC) Coordinator for East Africa from 2017 to 2019.

On his recall to Ghana in 2019, he was appointed as the Area Head for Haatso in the Greater Accra region.

He was elected International Missions Director (IMD) of The Church of Pentecost at the 45<sup>th</sup> Session of the General Council Meetings held from May 5-7, 2021, and inducted into office as the 5<sup>th</sup> IMD of The CoP on 12<sup>th</sup> September 2021.

He is married to Mrs Deborah Agyemang Bekoe and blessed with 4 children.

(Youth Director and Patron of PENSA International)

Ebenezer Hagan is the Youth Ministry Director of the Church of Pentecost, and the Patron of PENSA International, the Church's global campus ministry. He was called into the full time ministry of the Church of Pentecost in 2008 and served in Nyankpala in northern Ghana and PENSA Greater Accra Sector before his current appointment. He was called into the pastorate in 2013 and into apostleship in 2023. Before his call into full time ministry, he worked as an assistant engineer with Associated Consultants Ltd., a Civil Engineering consultancy firm in Accra.

Ebenezer is passionate about ministry to young people and has been a youth worker for 20 years. He is a PhD candidate (in Christian Education) at the Talbot School of Theology, Biola University, California, USA. He holds a Master of Theology (MTh) from the Trinity Theological Seminary, Legon-Ghana, an MA in Pentecostal Studies from the Pentecost University, and a BSc. in Civil Engineering from KNUST. He is a member of the Association of Youth Ministry Educators (AYME), the International Association for the Study of Youth Ministry (IASYM), and the Society for Professors of Christian Education (SPCE). He also serves on the leadership team of the Ghana Issachar Initiative of the Lausanne Movement. His two books, *Holistic Youth Development: Perspectives from Ghanaian (African) Pentecostal and Charismatic Christianity*, and *Lessons for the Young Anointed* were launched in January 2023 and are available both in print and kindle versions on amazon.

## PENSA INTERNATIONAL MANDATE

PENSA International since its inception has been charged to accomplish these four (4) major mandates.

### 1. PENSA Establishment Missions Mandate:

- To identify nations and campuses without PENSA;
- To mobilize appropriate resources with the support of existing COP tructures in order to establish PENSA in the identified nations and campuses;
- To open new PENSA branches in the nations and campuses identified;
- To support nations to formalize their newly opened PENSA branches.

### 2. Grounds Breaking Missions Mandate:

- To identify new grounds for missions in consultation with the International Missions office;
- To mobilize volunteer students and alumni from time to time for global mission trips. These teams of volunteers shall be called PENSA Force, and shall be used for groundbreaking missionary activities;
- To mobilize host and neighboring nations to support groundbreaking missions work.

### 3. Professional Networking Mandate:

- To network all students, alumni and professionals across th globe for fellowship and capacity development with the view to impact their societies with kingdom principles and values.

### 4. PENSA International Conference Mandate:

This is targeted at organizing an International Conference for all students and professionals across the globe with a dual purpose of establishing PENSAs in institutions and opening branches of COP through evangelism, in the nation where the Conference is chosen to be held.

# PENSA INTERNATIONAL ACTIVITIES

PENSA International since its inauguration zoomed into action and continued to make strides by the Grace of God to spread the gospel across nations. Various departments were set up to aid in its activities. It also embarked on a number of trips in fulfillment of its mandate. Some members of PENSA International attended conferences in the United States, China and Ivory Coast. Missions trips were embarked on to the Philippines, Nigeria, Togo, Rwanda and Uganda from the onset. The Covid-19 pandemic which resulted in the closure of borders and meant a halt to the work of missions propelled leadership to devise strategies that will ensure the continuity of mission works. Notable among the strategies employed were COVERED and IWIG.

## COVERED

Covered was aimed at raising prayer and worship across the globe on the basis of the Scripture; Exodus 12:13 which states that, "...the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt." This was to remind the entire world that when we put our trust in God, we will be "COVERED" by the blood of Jesus Christ during the global COVID-19 pandemic. Intensive prayers and worship were initially raised for a period of fourteen (14) hours via social media. Undertaking of this novel project required the collaboration of technical teams spread across selected nations for participation and streaming purposes. At the end of this program, the social media presence of PENSA International heightened and a number of testimonies of healings and others were received. Most importantly, eight (8) souls were won to Christ. In the post-pandemic era, COVERED remains an ongoing potent statement of global to our reliance on God alone.





# IWiG (I Will Go) Missions

The vision of IWiG, sought to mobilize, equip and deploy young men and women (mostly professionals) within the Church of Pentecost (COP) to strategically takeover the digital space for virtual missions targeted at a particular community of the world in a given period. In the year 2020, the Arab Community was targeted. Thus, IWiG sought to leverage on global connectivity via the internet by mobilizing a global force for the purposes of missions “virtually.” The stakeholders involved in this vision included; the International Missions Directorate of COP, Pentecost University and Oral Roberts University. A committee was set up to draw a plan for this missions activities from its inception. A registration portal was opened for volunteers to register and participate in this digital evangelism, grouped in categories of Virtual, Executive, Academic and Financial Missionaries who were duly trained for their specific tasks. A total of 3,821 volunteers participated in the missions activities in the stipulated categories. A total of 256,130 people were reached; 169 sent personal messaged, and a total of 12 people received salvation.
